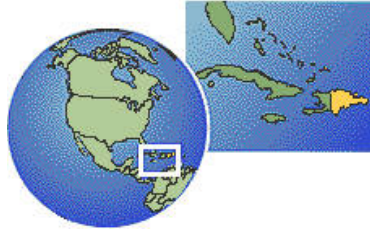


# Letter from La Victoria

Dear Father Proulx & Nativity Parish Family,

Many greetings from La Victoria. Today the group (**Nativity Life Teen**) is leaving, and I would like to send this note along to you and to your good people of Nativity. As I think I told you, you know that I am not in charge of the community anymore (our Schoenstatt Institute) for the country. Now Sr. M. Miguelina is in charge which gives me more time with the group. They were really a wonderful group. The teens and the adults blended in very harmoniously and they accomplished a lot. We have been very blessed, as always, with their visit. **Justin Lantz (Nativity Youth Director)** and **Ed Buckley (Nativity Assistant Youth Director)** did a fantastic job coordinating the different activities. They painted our wall behind the retreat house, helped put a concrete floor in a family's house, and they brought hope to a desperate mother who lost her home due to a fire. They gave words of consolation, immediate help with clothes, shoes, medication and other assistance, plus the promise to help with the building of a new house.

The teens were very good workers and very willing and helpful with painting at the Nutrition Center, the albergues (schools), at the clinic and in our house. **Henry McCloud (Nativity Maintenance)** was the perfect man to fix our fans and put in new ones. Let him come again so he may continue fixing things.

About the building project, Nutrition Center – our community is working first on the first level but only when we get done with the wall around the land.

We will need at least half of the money to start with so we can start searching for the additional funds. We are going to submit an application to the government and see how the good Lord will help us through them.

Thank you, Father Proulx, for the support. I send you and all of your parishioners many blessings from Our Lady of Schoenstatt.

The members of the Mission Board that were here will explain more to you about our project.
