A hunger for learning is, for some people, an acquired taste. Foster this hunger in your child by serving up a variety of experiences that teach and expand his or her world view. Here are a few tasty morsels that might whet your child's appetite and create some precious bonding time, as well!

- Buy two copies of a book and read along side your child. Discuss and compare your thoughts about a book you are experiencing together.
