Preparation Expectations for Remote Learning

- Check the school website for updates and recommendations <https://www.nativitycatholicsschool.org/>.
- Be sure the school has all of your current contact information (email addresses and phone numbers).
- Make sure you (student and parent/guardian) can access Office 365, student email, PlusPortals, and Clever.

- If you have trouble with access, please contact techhelp@nativitycatholicsschool.org.
- Students in 4th-8th will be permitted to checkout their Microsoft tablets and laptops. Repairs to a device that is damaged during remote learning will be the responsibility of the family.

Engagement Expectations for Remote Learning

- **Please have patience...**
 - with the teachers presenting lessons in a new and unfamiliar way.
 - with your child doing online learning.
 - with yourself, if you are unfamiliar with the platforms, apps, and websites, we will be using.
 - we will make progress, not perfection.
- If students need additional emotional support during this time, our school counselor, Mrs. Cseh can be available. Please make your initial contact via her email at schoolcounselor@nativitycatholicsschool.org. Mrs. Cseh will then let you know how to proceed.
- When possible, maintain school day routines at home like a typical day in school.
- Login to Plus Portals and Clever each school day.
- Complete your student activity log.
- Complete each assignment or activity to the best of the student's ability.
- Ask questions. Teachers are available via email at their @nativitycatholicsschool.org email.
- While teachers will be keeping virtual office hours, this is not the time for conferences. If you require a conference, please schedule one when regular classes resume.
- Watch for and meet deadlines. Submit assignments to teachers according to the instructions provided. Some student work may be turned in remotely.
- Maintain a reasonable pace of work and do not wait until the last minute to complete assignments or reach out for support.
- Appropriate use of school technology is crucial. Parents, please monitor students while using digital resources and/or equipment.

Closure Expectations for Remote Learning

- Return to school with all instructional materials and completed work not yet submitted to the teacher digitally.
- Formal assessments of skills and strategies learned remotely will occur upon return to school.
- Some lessons/content may need to be re-taught in person. Just as any lesson during "normal" school days, student assessment data may indicate a need to review content.
